The Harbor Island Moorings are intended for the use and enjoyment of the recreational boater. The Moorings are made available by the Island Alliance to provide access for boaters to the new national park area and to help raise revenues to preserve the natural resources while minimizing impacts and to raise awareness of the Boston Harbor Islands.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Payment is due with reservation or upon arrival.
2. Boat owner is responsible for any damage caused by excessive or negligent operation while on either the moorings or on the islands
3. Noise levels must be kept to a minimum after 10 PM
4. Children under 12 must wear life jackets
5. Moorings are intended for recreational use only and are not to be used during severe weather. Moorings are designed to hold a 50-foot vessel in 30-knot winds with 2-foot seas.
6. Rafting is permitted subject to size and weight limitations of moorings; please inquire of Island Moorings personnel.
7. Jet skis and other personal watercraft must follow all rules of the road and courtesies as all other vessels.
8. Observe specific island restrictions concerning landings
 - a. George's, Peddocks and Lovell's islands open daily until sunset – camping permits available for Lovells and Peddocks
 - b. Long, Gallop's and Rainford islands are closed to the public.

The Island Alliance, The Park Partnership, Island Moorings, Inc and Bosport Docking, Inc. are not responsible for theft, vandalism, misuse, fire, storm, acts of God, or any other cause beyond their control.
